WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the certified appraisal rolls for 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the expenses of the District and has adopted a budget for the ensuing fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the tax hereinafter levied must be levied to provide the revenue requirements of the budget for the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, the Order set out below was introduced for consideration of the Board. It was duly moved and seconded that said Order be adopted; and, after due discussion, said motion carried by the following vote:

NOW, THEREFORE be it ordered by the Board of Commissioners of Llano County Emergency Services District # 1 that the following rate be levied per \$100 valuation of taxable property for the year 2022:

**TOTAL TAX PER \$100 VALUATION: 0.016083**

**This year's tax rate will not raise more tax revenue for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate. The tax rate will effectively be .016083 percent and will not raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000.00 home.**
